Each winner's teacher will receive a \$40 gift certificate for educational materials. Winners and honorable mentions will receive tickets to Aquarium of the Pacific, courtesy of the Aquarium.

Winners will be announced by the end of April.

Art and poetry must have a California coastal or marine theme to be eligible. Please refer to the contest "Guidelines" for complete contest rules.

If you would like your original artwork returned, you *must* submit a self-addressed, stamped envelope of adequate size *with* your entry. Winners and honorable mentions may be retained by the Commission for approximately one year for public exhibit.
